A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew

Mt 5:17-37

our ancestors: You must not kill; and if
anyone does kill he must answer for it
before the court. But I say this to you:

commit adultery. But I say this to you: if a
man looks at a woman lustfully, he has
already committed adultery with her in his
