Eph 2:13-18

In Christ Jesus, you that used to be so far apart

ally destroying in his own person the hostility
caused by the rules and decrees of the Law.

PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty,
maker of heaven and earth, of all things
visible and invisible.
