Monday to Friday 9.30am


Saturday (Vigil Mass) 6pm.

Today, 18th October is World Mission Sunday Day - World Mission Sunday is Pope Francis' annual appeal for spiritual and financial support so the life-giving work of overseas' missionaries can continue. PROFESSION OF FAITH
