Dear Parishioners,

*“Let’s make sure our Sacred Space
remains a Safe Place”.*

After several very difficult weeks I am delighted to be able to welcome you back to our Churches for Mass from Monday June 29th. While this is very positive it is not without many challenges and restrictions.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays since the beginning of restrictions will remain removed. We encourage you to attend weekday Mass at Church of Our Lady Monday – Saturday 10.30 am - which you may find more suitable both in numbers attending and personal safety.

To ensure that our “Sacred Place is a Safe Place” restrictions will be in place and we all have a responsibility to comply with the protocols as set out below.

Social distancing: Two meters social distancing applies with the exception when persons from the same household may sit together where appropriate seating is available.

Church Numbers: Our Church numbers will be restricted to Roslevan 140, Doora 80, Barefield 90.

Mass Times:

Church Of Our Lady: From Monday June 29th. and each week Mondays to Saturdays Mass will be held daily @ 10.30 am. Mass on Saturday will continue @ 6pm.

We will not have Mass on Sunday at Church Of Our Lady.

All these Masses will continue to be streamed on our Parish Webcam.

Doora: From Sunday July 5th. and each Sunday thereafter Mass will be @ 10 am

Barefield: From Sunday July 5th. and each Sunday thereafter Mass will be @ 11 am

Hand sanitization facilities are in all Church porches for use entering and leaving. Let’s not forget the Virus has not gone away, we need to not just safeguard ourselves but also safeguard each other.

A reading from the letter of St. Paul to the Romans

Rm 5:12-15

Sin entered the world through one man, and
through sin death, and thus death has spread
through the whole human race because everyone
has sinned. Sin existed in the world long before
the Law was given. There was no law and so no
one could be accused on the sin of 'law-breaking',
yet death reigned over all from Adam to Moses,
even though their sin, unlike that of Adam, was
not a matter of breaking a law.

Adam prefigured the One to come, but the gift
itself considerably outweighed the fall. If it is
certain that through one man's fall so many died,
it is even more certain that divine grace, coming
through the one man, Jesus Christ, came to so

PROFESSION OF FAITH
