Face Coverings in Church

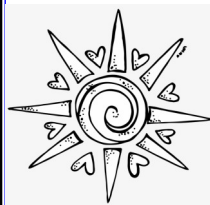

prophets.' 'But you,' he said 'who do you say I

my Father in heaven. So I now say to

Then he gave the disciples strict orders

PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father
