

Celebration of Holy Communion & Confirmation



Dear Parishioners, Some necessary Time Changes

"Let's make sure our Sacred Space remains a Safe Place".

After several very difficult weeks I am delighted to be able to welcome you back to our Churches for Mass from Monday June 29th. While this is very positive it is not without many challenges and restrictions.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays since the beginning of restrictions will remain removed. We encourage you to attend weekday Mass at Church of Our Lady

Monday - Saturday 9.30 am - which you may find more suitable both in numbers attending and personal safety. This will also afford the possibility for people who are not free to attend during the week to do so on Saturday evening and Sunday.

To ensure that our "Sacred Place is a Safe Place" restrictions will be in place and we all have a responsibility to comply with the protocols as set out below.

<u>Social distancing</u>: Two meters social distancing applies with the <u>exception when persons</u> <u>from the same household</u> may sit together where appropriate seating is available.

<u>Church Numbers</u>: As you will know through national media that our capacity for Mass is subject to 2 meter social distancing unless you share seating with someone from your household. Please understand if its not possible to attend if allowed capacity has been reached when you arrive.

Mass Times:

Church Of Our Lady: From Monday June 29th and each week Mondays to Saturdays Mass will be held daily @ **9.30 am**. Mass on Saturday will continue @ **6pm**. We will not have Mass on Sunday at Church Of Our Lady.

All Masses scheduled for Church of Our Lady will continue to be streamed on our Parish Webcam.

Please note slight change in Sunday Mass times. I need this change as I need to be available in both churches in advance of Mass beginning.

Doora: From Sunday July 5th. and each Sunday Mass will be @ 9.45 am

Barefield: From Sunday July 5th. and each Sunday Mass will be @ 11.15 am

Hand sanitization facilities are in all Church porches for use entering and leaving. Let's not forget the Virus has not gone away, we need to not just safeguard ourselves but also safeguard each other.

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Romans. Rom 6:3-4.8-11

When we were baptised in Christ Jesus we were baptised in his death; in other words, when we were baptized we went into the tomb with him and joined him in death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the father's glory, we too might live a new life.

But we believe that having died with Christ we shall return to life with him; Christ as we know having been raised from the dead will never die again. Death has no power over him any more. When he died, he died, once for all, to sin, so his life now is life with God; and in that way, you too must consider yourselves to be dead to sin but alive for God in Christ Jesus.

PROFESSION OF FAITH
