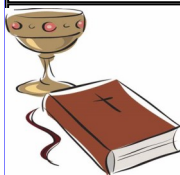
### Anniversary Masses

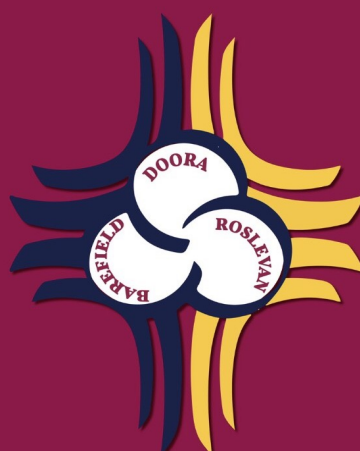

# WELCOME TO MASS

Dear Parishioners,      Some necessary Time Changes

*“Let’s make sure our Sacred Space  
remains a Safe Place”.*

After several very difficult weeks I am delighted to be able to welcome you back to our Churches for Mass from Monday June 29<sup>th</sup>. While this is very positive it is not without many challenges and restrictions.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays since the beginning of restrictions will remain removed. We encourage you to attend weekday Mass at Church of Our Lady

**Monday – Saturday 9.30 am** - which you may find more suitable both in numbers attending and personal safety. This will also afford the possibility for people who are not free to attend during the week to do so on Saturday evening and Sunday.

To ensure that our “Sacred Place is a Safe Place” restrictions will be in place and we all have a responsibility to comply with the protocols as set out below.

Social distancing: Two meters social distancing applies with the exception when persons from the same household may sit together where appropriate seating is available.

**Church Numbers: As you may have heard through media we will be restricted to 50 people attending until July 20th. Please understand if its not possible to attend if this number has been reached when you arrive.**

Mass Times:

Church Of Our Lady: From Monday June 29<sup>th</sup> and each week Mondays to Saturdays Mass will be held daily @ **9.30 am**. Mass on Saturday will continue @ **6pm**.

We will not have Mass on Sunday at Church Of Our Lady.

All Masses scheduled for Church of Our Lady will continue to be streamed on our Parish Webcam.

**Please note slight change in Sunday Mass times. I need this change as I need to be available in both churches in advance of Mass beginning.**

**Doora: From Sunday July 5<sup>th</sup>. and each Sunday Mass will be @ 9.45 am**

**Barefield: From Sunday July 5<sup>th</sup>. and each Sunday Mass will be @ 11.15 am**

Hand sanitization facilities are in all Church porches for use entering and leaving. Let’s not forget the Virus has not gone away, we need to not just safeguard ourselves but also safeguard each other.

NB: Volunteers for each Weekend Masses are required as ushers and I would appreciate your assistance. Please contact me 086 2508444.

**NB: 50 people is our maximum allowed attendance if you arrive after this figure is reached please do not be offended if its not possible to attend.**
