 with you: the evidence of two or three witnesses
 is required to sustain any charge. But if he
 refuses to listen to these, report it to the
 community; and if he refuses to listen to the
 community, treat him like a pagan or
 tax collector.'

 heaven; whatever you lose on earth
 shall be considered lost in heaven.
 'I tell you solemnly once again, if two
 of you on earth agree to ask anything
 at all, it will be granted to you by my

PROFESSION OF FAITH
