Migraine Association of Ireland is delighted to announce an Online event presented by Professor Billy O'Connor, Neuroscientist, Graduate Medical School, University of Limerick. This online seminar will take place online on Wednesday 10th June from 7pm - 9pm and will touch on recent neuroscience findings on how our brain responds to pain and will discuss lifestyle adaptations to help with migraine pain. Professor William T. (Billy) O'Connor is Foundation Chair and Head of Teaching and Research in Physiology at the University of Limerick Medical School. His research focus includes an



understanding of illness of mind and brain as a disorder of the nerve network, and in the emerging field of neuro-education - the brain science of learning, which arose from his long-standing interest in education. Dear Parishioners

In our Newsletters in mid-May I set out the serious challenges we all faced on continuing our Church Ceremonies due to the Coronavirus Pandemic. With our Churches closed we installed a Webcam at Church of Our Lady to bring Church ceremonies to you our Parishioners and to a wider National and International audience. This service allows us to bring a range of ceremonies to you which we understand are very well received.

We are now focusing on the pathway to getting our Churches back to some normality with the first step on May 18th when our Churches were opened for private prayer. To comply with HSE requirements we installed sanitizer facilities and signage to remind us all of our need to care for each other. On July 20th. it is expected to begin celebrating Mass with people present - social distancing will apply. Christenings with small numbers present may also be reintroduced. While it is a challenge we are working on having both Holy Communion and Confirmation Ceremonies rearranged.

I wish to thank you sincerely for your continued generous contributions to our Parish which are vital to the ongoing funding of our Parish services. As outlined in past Newsletters these contributions can be made directly to our Parish Office at 3 The Woods, Cappahard, Tulla Road, by using your Development Fund envelopes or an ordinary envelope with your name/s and address.

To facilitate you paying your contributions we have now introduced an online service which is available on our Parish Website <u>www.doorabarefieldparish.ie</u> - click "Donate". This facility has three sections where you can donate an individual amount or choose an ongoing payment option.

The three sections are:

- <u>Parish Funds</u>: These funds are for the day to day running of our Parish and supplements our weekly Basket & Development Fund collections.
- <u>Priests Collections</u>: These funds go to paying our Priest with surplus going to Pastoral care in the Diocese. There are four collections annually and we will give you notice of upcoming collection dates.

<u>Other Collections</u>: These funds go to eight individual groups including Trocaire, Lourdes Invalid Fund etc. We will also advise you on these upcoming collection dates.

These are extremely challenging times for us all and while we are now asked to stay apart with social distancing we are a very strong community which is evidenced by the wonderful voluntary contribution and support of our Parish Clubs, Societies, and individuals. To all of you I say a very special thank you. Together we will see this through and be stronger and better people.
