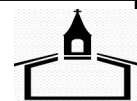

Pilgrimage to Oberammergau - The Killaloe Diocese has secured 40 tickets for the famous Passion Play that is held in Oberammergau Germany Bishop Fintan Monahan will lead a Killaloe the Diocesan Pilgrimage to the famous Passion Play at Oberammergau, Germany from 29th August to 2nd September this year.
