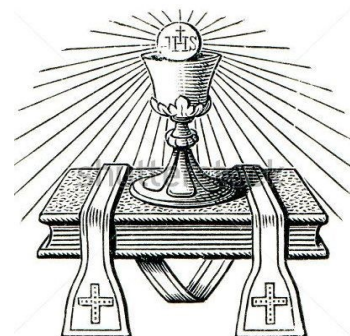

## A reading from the book of the Apocalypse. Apoc 11:19; 12:1-6.10

The sanctuary of God in heaven opened,  
and the ark of the covenant could be seen  
inside it. Now a great sign appeared in  
heaven: a woman, adorned with the sun,  
standing on the moon, and with the twelve  
stars on her head for a crown. She was  
pregnant, and in labour, crying aloud in the  
pangs of childbirth. Then a second sign  
appeared in the sky, a huge red dragon  
which had seven heads and ten horns,  
and each of the seven heads crowned with  
a coronet. Its tail dragged a third of the stars  
from the sky and dropped them to the earth,  
and the dragon stopped in front of the  
woman as she was having the child, so that  
he could eat it as soon as it was born from  
its mother.

The woman brought a male child into the  
world, the son who was to rule all the  
nations with an iron sceptre, and the child  
was taken straight up to God and to his  
throne, while the woman escaped into the  
desert, where God had made a place of  
safety ready. Then I heard a voice shout  
from heaven, "*Victory and  
power and empire for ever have been won  
by our God, and all authority for his Christ.*"

## A reading from the first letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians. 1 Cor 15:20-26

Adam, so all will be brought to life in Christ;  
but all of them in their proper order: Christ as

away with every sovereignty, authority and  
power. For he must be king until he has put  
all his enemies under his feet and the last of

## A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke. Lk 1:39-56

Mary set out and went as quickly as she could to  
a town in the hill country of Judah. She went into  
Zechariah's house and greeted Elizabeth. Now  
as soon as Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the  
child leapt in her womb and Elizabeth was filled  
with the Holy Spirit.

She gave a loud cry and said, 'Of all women you  
are the most blessed, and blessed is the fruit of  
your womb. Why should I be honoured with a  
visit from the mother of my Lord? From the  
moment your greeting reached my ears, the child  
in my womb leapt for joy. Yes, blessed is she  
who believed that the promise made to her by  
the Lord would be fulfilled.'

## PROFESSION OF FAITH
