## A reading from the holy Gospel according to John.

### Jn 6:41-51.

The Jews were complaining to each other  
about Jesus, because he had said, 'I am  
the bread that came down from heaven.'  
'Surely this is Jesus son of Joseph' they  
said. 'We know his father and mother. How  
can he now say, "I have come down from  
heaven"?' Jesus said in reply, 'Stop  
complaining to each other.'

'No one can come to me unless he is  
drawn by the Father who sent me, and I  
will raise him up at the last day.'

It is written in the prophets:

They will all be taught by God, and to  
hear the teaching of the Father, and  
learn from it, is to come to me. Not that  
anybody has seen the Father, except  
the one who comes from God:  
he has seen the Father.

## PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty,  
maker of heaven and earth, of all things  
visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,  
the Only Begotten Son of God,  
born of the Father before all ages.

God from God, Light from Light,  
true God from true God, begotten, not  
made, consubstantial with the Father;  
through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation  
he came down from heaven, and by the  
Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin  
Mary, and became man. For our sake he  
was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he  
suffered death and was buried, and rose  
again on the third day In accordance with  
the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven  
and is seated at the right hand of the  
Father. He will come again in glory to  
judge the living and the dead and his  
kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the  
giver of life, who proceeds from the Father

spoken through the prophets.
