bunched up in stress and strain.*

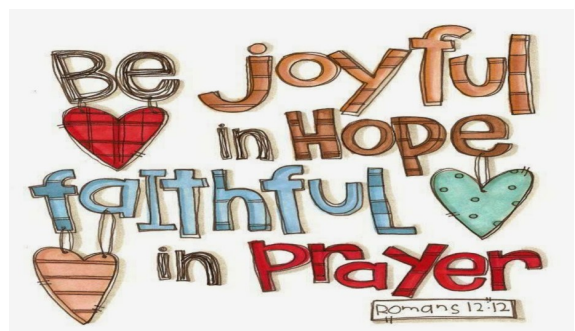
*Let me fall headfirst into the truth

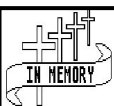

Barefield Church Notice -
Restoration of Stained Glass Windows

Phase 1. The 3 altar windows and St. Therese window will be removed from the Church for Conservation & Restoration in the coming week.

These windows date back to the 1920's. Cannon Stained Glass Studios have been awarded the contract which will take approximately 12 weeks to complete. The Parish has been granted a Heritage Grant towards the project.

Phase 2. This phase will be done later to Conserve & Restore the remaining windows of the church.


