COME TO ME ALL YOU WHO ARE BURDENED

"Shoulder my yoke and learn from me For I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest"

Many memories as a child of the 'yoke' as a wooden beam used between two horses to enable them to pull together on a load or a plough, when working in pairs.

The accompanying chains always needed to be of same length to distribute the weight evenly.



Jesus was all too aware of how the people he'd encountered were laden with the toughest of burdens by the Pharisees who imposed the Mosaic law mercilessly. As he so often did, he set about rectifying the weight of the load many were carrying. We may live a long time from those Biblical memories, but some things never change. Burdens are still imposed and the weight of them can be mercilessly difficult to carry .. Alone.

He tells us to take 'his' yoke, which is easy and his burden is light. The yoke of Christ can be seen as our responsibilities and duties as followers of Christ. Realising we can be 'Christ' to another whose burden is just too much without a helping hand or ear.

For <u>our</u> burden to be 'lighter', could we be open to accept to be 'yoked' together with Christ, meaning walking step in step with him. Trusting his invitation ... 'come to me all you who labour and are overburdened and I will give you rest'

My go to prayer when the burden is a shade too heavy:

"Lord help me believe that nothing will happen me today that you and I can't handle together"
