#### The Most Holy Trinity- Solemnity



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to reflect on the deepest mystery of our faith — a God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, united in perfect love. In today's Gospel, Jesus reveals the heart of God's love: "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son." The Father's love is shown in the gift of His Son, and through the Holy Spirit we are drawn into this saving love.

Jesus did not come to condemn the world, but to save it. This reminds us that God's desire is always mercy, forgiveness, and new life. The Trinity is not distant from us; God walks with us each day, calling us to live in faith, unity, and love.

As followers of Christ, we are invited to reflect the love of the Trinity in our homes, parish, and community — through kindness, compassion, prayer, and care for one another.

Traditionally, the month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary on May 31st beautifully brings this Marian Month to a joyful conclusion.

In Mary's journey to visit Elizabeth, we see a living example of love in action, humble service, and faith-filled joy. As we honour Our Lady today, may she continue to lead us closer to the Holy Trinity and inspire us to bring Christ's love to others.

### HSE Community Healthcare Programme

HSE Mid-West Community Healthcare are running the 'Living Well' programme which is a free of charge group self-management programme for people with long term health conditions or their carers.

## The Gospel of the Lord

### PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages.

God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. **Amen.**
